AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH H2M ARCHITECTS & ENGINEERS FOR THE CLARKSVILLE 911-EOC PROJECT

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with H2M Architects & Engineers regarding construction management services for the Clarksville 911-EOC project located in Clarksville, New York in an amount not to exceed \$813,250, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Purchasing Department issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Construction Management Services for the Construction of the Clarksville 911-EOC project in Clarksville, New York, and

WHEREAS, Eleven proposals were received in response to the RFP and H2M Architects & Engineers was considered the most qualified to provide the services and meets or exceeds all criteria as set forth in the RFP, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with H2M Architects & Engineers, Latham, NY 12110 regarding construction management services for the Clarksville 911-EOC project located in Clarksville, New York in an amount not to exceed \$813,250, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
