AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH MILDRED ELLEY SCHOOL REGARDING EDUCATIONAL TRAINING FOR PRACTICAL NURSES AT THE ALBANY COUNTY NURSING HOME

WHEREAS, The Executive Director of the Department of Residential Health Care Facilities has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Mildred Elley School regarding a partnership that will allow their Practical Nursing Clinical students to receive training at the Albany County Nursing Home (ACNH), and

WHEREAS, Mildred Elley School staff will supervise students who will provide direct care to the residents of the Nursing Home and gain practical nursing experience and each student and instructor shall carry liability insurance for the program, and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director indicated that this agreement would be at no cost to Albany County and would assist ongoing recruitment efforts to fill vacant Practical Nursing positions at the ACNH, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Mildred Elley School regarding a partnership that will allow their Practical Nursing Clinical Students to receive training at the Albany County Nursing Home, and that such program may be terminated by either party with a 60-day notice, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
