

## RESOLUTION NO. 152

### **AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY DISABILITY ASSISTANCE AND INTERFAITH PARTNERSHIP FOR THE HOMELESS AND AMENDING THE 2018 DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES BUDGET**

By Social Services Committee, Mss. Chapman and Willingham:

WHEREAS, Governor Andrew Cuomo issued Executive Order 151 (EO 151) to protect homeless individuals from inclement winter weather and the risk of hypothermia, serious injury and death where temperatures drop to 32 degrees or below by requiring homeless shelters to extend their hours of operation, and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to EO 151, Interfaith Partnership Safe Haven extended their hours of operation for their drop-in shelter to include weekends for overflow of homeless persons during inclement winter weather, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has requested authorization to submit a grant application and to accept funding from the NYS Office of Temporary Disability Assistance (NYSOTDA) in order to reimburse Interfaith Partnership for the Homeless in the amount of \$121,074 for providing additional services pursuant to EO 151 for the term commencing October 1, 2017 and ending September 30, 2018, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of Temporary Disability Assistance to accept funding in the amount of \$121,074 in order to reimburse Interfaith Partnership for the Homeless regarding the aforementioned services for the term commencing October 1, 2017 and ending September 30, 2018, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that in order to accept the aforementioned funding the 2018 Department of Social Services Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3640 Safety Net by \$121,074

Increase Appropriation Account A6140.4 by \$121,074 by increasing Line Item A6140 4 4046 Fees for Services by \$121,074

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
