WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Mental Health has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the Mental Health Empowerment Project regarding the provision of homeless peer advocacy services for individuals suffering from mental illness in an amount not to exceed \$112,753 for a term commencing January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Mental Health Empowerment Project regarding the provision of homeless peer advocacy services for individuals suffering from mental illness in an amount not to exceed \$112,753 for a term commencing January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
