AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES AND CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION REGARDING THE FOOD STAMP NUTRITION EDUCATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension regarding the Food Stamp Nutrition Education Program in an amount not to exceed \$267,704 for the period commencing October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014 , and

WHEREAS, The services under this program will be provided by the Cornell Cooperative Extension staff to all Albany County Food Stamp recipients and participants in the Albany County Department of Social Services Children Assistance Program to promote nutritional health and maximize food stamp benefits as a means of accelerating the rate of self-sufficiency for eligible participants, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to execute an agreement between the Department of Social Services and Cornell Cooperative Extension regarding the Food Stamp Nutrition Education Program in an amount not to exceed \$267,704 for the period commencing October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
