

RESOLUTION NO. 83

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SEWER DISTRICT AND THE ALBANY COUNTY AIRPORT AUTHORITY REGARDING DE-ICING WASTE TREATMENT

Introduced: 3/10/14

By Public Works Committee:

WHEREAS, De-icing activities at the Albany County Airport result in a substantial runoff and accumulation of glycol-laden wastewater, and

WHEREAS, The Airport authority has determined that should an emergency arise with their treatment system, that the most viable alternative for the emergency treatment of glycol-laden wastewater is the Albany County Sewer District facilities, and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director of the Albany County Sewer District has requested authorization to enter into a five-year agreement, with an option for an additional five-year term, with the Albany County Airport Authority regarding the emergency treatment of glycol-laden wastewater, annual laboratory analysis and sludge disposal in an annual amount estimated to be \$10,000, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a five-year agreement, with an option to renew for an additional five-year term, between the Albany County Sewer District and the Albany County Airport Authority regarding the emergency treatment of glycol-laden wastewater, annual laboratory analysis and sludge disposal at an estimated annual fee of \$10,000 plus additional fees for services performed exceeding routine waste treatment as per the agreement, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
