

RESOLUTION NO. 102

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SCHOHARIE COUNTY REGARDING TEMPORARY HOUSING FOR INMATES AT THE ALBANY COUNTY CORRECTIONAL FACILITY DUE TO DAMAGE CAUSED BY HURRICANE IRENE

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to move forward with a three-year agreement between the County of Albany and the County of Schoharie to provide temporary housing for Schoharie County adult inmates at the Albany County Correctional Facility commencing January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2016 with the option to renew for two additional one-year periods, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has agreed to furnish housing, meals, medical care and proper supervision for inmates transported to the Albany County Correctional Facility from Schoharie County, and

WHEREAS, The Schoharie County Sheriff has agreed to pay Albany County the sum of \$80 per day for each inmate housed in the Albany County Correctional Facility plus all off-site care and pharmaceutical expenses, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a three-year agreement with Schoharie County to provide temporary housing for Schoharie County adult inmates at the Albany County Correctional Facility for a term beginning January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2016 at a fee of \$80 per day per inmate plus off-site expenses with the option to renew for two additional one-year periods, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
