SUPPORTING THE ALBANY CAPITAL CENTER PROJECT BY CONVEYING A PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY ONCE THE TECHNICAL STEPS NECESSARY TO PROPERLY CONVEY SAID PARCEL HAVE BEEN COMPLETED

WHEREAS, The Albany Convention Center Authority was created in 2004 to meet an immediate need to institute a comprehensive, coordinated program of convention activities in the City of Albany and through tireless dedication, the members of the Convention Center Authority are on the verge of realizing their goal with the soon to be constructed Albany Capital Center, and

WHEREAS, The creation of new jobs and the increase in tax revenues are but a part of the advantages the new center promises to provide the residents of Albany County, and

WHEREAS, In order to move forward in a timely manner, the Albany Convention Center Authority requires a small portion of property currently included in the Civic Center parcel, and

WHEREAS, In order to convey the area of approximately .33 acre to the Convention Center Authority, certain technical steps must be completed to ensure that the parcel is properly and correctly transferred, and

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body continues to support the mission of the Convention Center Authority and the construction of the Albany Capital Center by supporting the transfer of the aforementioned piece of property once the technical requirements are met, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is requested to take all steps to immediately submit the documentation required to allow this Honorable Body to properly convey the aforementioned .33 acre to the Albany Convention Center Authority, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is requested to assist with the development of the applicable and necessary documents to accomplish the goal of this resolution, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
