ESTABLISHING A STANDARD WORKDAY FOR RETIREMENT REPORTING PURPOSES

WHEREAS, The New York State Employees' Retirement System requires that a standard workday be established for all County of Albany employees, including elected officials, for retirement reporting purposes, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That for retirement reporting purposes a standard workday of six hours per day for a five-day workweek is hereby established for County Legislators, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That for retirement reporting purposes a standard workday of seven hours per day for a five-day workweek is hereby established for the following elected and appointed positions:

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature hereby establishes the above as standard workdays for its elected officials and appointed officials and will report days worked to the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System as per the requirements of the Office of the New York State Comptroller and as indicated in documents filed with the Clerk of the Legislature all in substantially the form thereof presented to the Legislature at this meeting and based on the time keeping system or the record of activities maintained for three consecutive months and submitted to the Clerk of the Legislature, said document shall be filed with the New York State Comptroller, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
