WHEREAS, The Albany County Clerk has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Glenmont Job Corps regarding a work-based learning program internship for a period no longer than six weeks, and

WHEREAS, The Clerk has indicated that this will allow Albany County to establish a work based learning program with the Glenmont Job Corps, 822 River Road, Glenmont and is federally funded which will operate at no cost to the County, and

WHEREAS, Students between the ages of 20 through 24 are offered an opportunity to participate in the Work Based Learning Program Internship in the Albany County Clerk's Office, to learn basic professional skills necessary to work in a business environment, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Glenmont Job Corps, 822 River Road, Glenmont, NY for up to six weeks, at no cost to the County regarding the Work Based Learning Program Internship, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
