ESTABLISHING THE ALBANY COUNTY INTEROPERABLE COMMUNICATIONS CONSORTIUM BY AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ALBANY AND TOWN OF COLONIE PERTAINING TO A REGIONAL COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to establish the Albany County Interoperable Communications Consortium by authorizing a ten year agreement with the City of Albany and Town of Colonie pertaining to a regional communications system, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has indicated that the Albany County Interoperable Communications Consortium (ACICC) will be governed by a regulatory board of directors for the purposes of implementing, managing and creating policy to govern, the board will consist of the following representatives, the Albany County Sheriff, the City of Albany Chief of Police, and the Town of Colonie Chief of Police or their designees, and

WHEREAS, The charge of the ACICC is to work on building a countywide interoperable communications network using existing infrastructure and replacing, upgrading and purchasing new infrastructure by the County of Albany through a combination of federal grants and a bond, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff also indicated that the Albany County Interoperable Communications Consortium will evenly divide the annual maintenance cost and that each agency is responsible for the costs of maintaining its own physical primary site, including any taxes, heating and cooling systems, electricity, backup power, fire suppression systems, routine service and repairs of radio tower sites and any elective service contracts that pertain to its own communications system, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to establish the Albany County Interoperable Communications Consortium by entering into a ten year agreement with the City of Albany and Town of Colonie pertaining to a regional communications system, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
