

RESOLUTION NO. 261

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT REGARDING THE COMMUNITY OVERDOSE PREVENTION PROGRAM AND AMENDING THE 2014 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, The NYS Office of the Attorney General has indicated that the County is eligible to receive a grant in the amount of \$2,520 regarding the Community Overdose Prevention Program, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has requested authorization to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of the Attorney General in the amount of \$2,520 regarding the Community Overdose Prevention Program, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that the grant funding will be used to purchase and equip first responding law enforcement personnel with kits to assist and treat victims of overdoses in an attempt to reverse the drug effects, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff also requested a budget amendment in order to incorporate the aforementioned funding into the 2014 Department's Budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of the Attorney General in an amount not to exceed \$2,520 regarding the Community Overdose Prevention Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2014 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Create and Increase Revenue Account A3515 Community Overdose Program by \$2,520

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.4 by increasing Line Item A3110 4 4028 Safety Supplies by \$2,520

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
