

RESOLUTION NO. 302

AMENDING THE 2014 COMPTROLLER'S BUDGET: CREATING A DIRECTOR OF MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS POSITION

Introduced: 8/11/14

By Audit and Finance Committee:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Comptroller has requested authorization to create a full-time Director of Municipal Affairs position to assist in the creation of two comprehensive data bases that would be used to develop models for reducing local government staffing without a reduction in services, and

WHEREAS, To accomplish this, the Comptroller has requested a budget amendment to create and appropriate funds for the new position, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2014 Department of Audit and Control Budget in Appropriation Account A1315.1 is amended as follows:

Create and Increase Line Item A1315 1 1351 001 Director of Municipal Affairs by \$31,132 for the balance of fiscal year 2014 with an annual salary of \$71,837

Decrease Line Item A1315 1 2521 001 Auditor by \$17,547 for the balance of fiscal year 2014 with an annual salary of \$40,000

Decrease Line Item A1315 1 5502 001 Administrative Aide PT by \$13,585 for the balance of fiscal year 2014 with an annual salary of \$31,837

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
