

RESOLUTION NO. 311

AUTHORIZING AN INTERDEPARTMENTAL AGREEMENT REGARDING NON-RESIDENTIAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SERVICES

By Law Committee and Mr. Clenahan:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services and Director of the Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center have requested authorization to enter into an interdepartmental agreement in the amount of \$141,037 in order to provide a range of non-residential services to victims of domestic violence for the period January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015, and

WHEREAS, The agreement will authorize the continuation of a 24-hour domestic violence hotline and walk-in assistance; domestic violence residential placements; information and referrals; advocacy and counseling, as well as, outreach and education for victims of domestic violence and their families, and

WHEREAS, Additional advocacy services will be provided to ten TANF eligible victims of domestic violence to make a successful transition from domestic violence shelters to permanent housing and to ensure and enhance the safety of victims to increase opportunities for self-sufficiency and violence-free living, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an interdepartmental agreement between the Department of Social Services and the Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center for the provision of non-residential services to victims of domestic violence in the amount of \$141,037 commencing January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
