

RESOLUTION NO. 334

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS REGARDING YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS AND AMENDING THE 2014 DEPARTMENT FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES BUDGET

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, Due to recent New York State regulatory changes, effective January 1, 2014, local youth bureaus now have full responsibility regarding the payment of municipal claims out of the annual State Aid allocation to the County from the New York State Office of Children and Families Services, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter into agreements with the following Albany County municipalities in the amounts listed below not to exceed \$102,935 regarding the provision of Youth Bureau Services for a period beginning January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2014:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner also has requested an amendment to the Department's 2014 Budget in order to incorporate the \$102,935 in State Aid, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into agreements with the aforementioned Albany County municipalities in the amounts listed above regarding the provision of Youth Bureau Services for the period beginning January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2014, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2014 Department for Children, Youth and Families Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3820 Division for Youth by \$102,935

Increase Appropriation Account A6119.4 by \$102,935 by increasing Line Item A6119 4 4406 Division for Youth by \$102,935

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
