

RESOLUTION NO. 340

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY REGARDING UPDATING THE ALBANY COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

By Public Safety Committee and Mr. Clenahan:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has been notified by the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, Office of Emergency Management that \$112,500 is available from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for updating the Albany County All Hazards Mitigation Plan, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has indicated that a 25% County match up to a maximum amount of \$37,500 is required and that the All Hazards Mitigation Plan will establish Albany County's commitment to reduce risks from natural hazards and serve as a tool for decision makers to commit resources that will reduce the effects of flooding, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff requested authorization to submit a grant application and to enter into an agreement with the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding the Albany County All Hazards Mitigation Plan in the amount of \$150,000, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement with the New York State Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, Office of Emergency Management regarding updating the Albany County All Hazards Mitigation Plan in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 which includes a 25% County match in the maximum amount of \$37,500, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
