

RESOLUTION NO. 342

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ALBANY REGARDING THE COUNTYWIDE INTEROPERABLE COMMUNICATION PROJECT AND AMENDING THE 2014 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET

By Public Safety Committee:

WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department has requested authorization to enter into a two-year inter-municipal agreement with the City of Albany regarding the Countywide Interoperable Communication Project in the amount of \$154,284 for the period commencing September 1, 2013 and ending August 31, 2015, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services awarded the aforementioned grant funding to the City of Albany for the Countywide Interoperable Communication Project being facilitated by the Albany County Sheriff's Office, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that in order to facilitate the purchase of equipment through this funding source, the County must make the initial purchase and then be reimbursed by the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has also requested a budget amendment to accept the aforementioned funding from the City of Albany for the initial purchase of equipment for the Countywide Interoperable Communication Project, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Albany regarding the Countywide Interoperable Communication Project in the amount of \$154,284 for the period September 1, 2013 to August 31, 2015, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2014 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3306 Homeland Security by \$154,284

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.2 by increasing Line Item A3110 2 2750 Security Equipment by \$154,284

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
