

RESOLUTION NO. 357

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH DELAWARE ENGINEERING, P.C. REGARDING THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW FOR THE PROPOSED SOLDIER ON PROJECT

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 263 for 2014, the Albany County Legislature expressed its intent to assume Lead Agency status for the State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) for the sole purpose of determining any potential environmental impacts that the proposed Soldier On project might have regarding the historic area involved, and

WHEREAS, The County Purchasing Agent issued a Request for Proposals seeking proposals to assist the County in conducting an environmental review of the proposed Soldier On project and completing all necessary studies, processes, correspondence, notifications, and filings, as appropriate and necessary, associated with Lead Agency responsibilities under the SEQR Act, and

WHEREAS, A legislative review group appointed by the Chairman, with input from staff from the Planning Department and the Department of Public Works, reviewed the seven proposals received and recommended awarding the work to Delaware Engineering, P.C. for the SEQR process, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Delaware Engineering, P.C., 28 Madison Avenue Extension, Albany, New York 12203 regarding the State Environmental Quality Review for the proposed Soldier On project in the amount indicated in the submitted proposal, said fees to be paid by Soldier On, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
