

RESOLUTION NO. 379

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ARJO HUNTLEIGH GETINGE GROUP REGARDING LIFT AND BATHING EQUIPMENT AND AMENDING THE 2014 RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITY BUDGET

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, After a full facility assessment by the Residential Care Facility National Emphasis Program of existing equipment to consider resident mobility levels, clinical needs, and current practices it was determined that there is a lack of equipment and existing equipment is obsolete and unserviceable, and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director of the Department of Residential Health Care Facilities has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with ArjoHuntleigh Getinge Group regarding the purchase and training for modern lift and bathing equipment in order to provide proper and safe care to the residents and nursing home staff when transferring and bathing residents, and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director has also requested a transfer of funds within the Department of Residential Health Care Facility budget to cover the cost of the ArjoHuntleigh Getinge bathing equipment and nursing home staff education and training for the utilization of the equipment, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with ArjoHuntleigh Getinge Group, 2349 West Lake St., Addison, IL, regarding the purchase of modern lift and bathing equipment in an amount not to exceed \$249,661.10, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2014 Department of Residential Health Care Facility Budget is amended as follows:

Decrease Appropriation Account NH6020.4 by \$280,737 by decreasing Line Item NH6020 4 4996 LDC Start Up Fund by \$280,737

Increase Appropriation Account NH6020.4 by \$31,075 by increasing Line Item NH6020 4 4069 Purchased Services by \$31,075

Increase Appropriation Account NH 6020.2 by \$249,662 by increasing Line Item NH6020 2 2610 Nursing Equipment by \$249,662

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
