

RESOLUTION NO. 409

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ULSTER COUNTY TO PROVIDE MICROGRAPHIC SERVICES WITH THE ALBANY COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE

By Law Committee:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Clerk has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Ulster County to provide Micrographic Services which includes the processing of microfilm from CD's for all land records and to also process the raw film from the Hall of Records into microfilm, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Hall of Records requires specialized services to produce and process microfilm which services have become increasingly difficult to procure, and

WHEREAS, Albany County does not have the necessary equipment to provide this type of service and Ulster County has indicated its willingness to provide the service at an annual expense not to exceed \$22,500 for the period beginning January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2016, and

WHEREAS, The Ulster County Hall of Records has a long history of providing high quality services of this nature to local governments, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Ulster County in an annual amount not to exceed \$22,500 for the period beginning January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2016 to reimburse Ulster County for micrographic services, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
