CREATING A SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON TAXATION

WHEREAS, Albany County has just completed one of the most difficult budgets in recent history, and

WHEREAS, During its deliberations, the Legislature has concluded that changes are necessary as the County cannot continue to exceed the 2% tax cap, and

WHEREAS, The County Legislature needs to advance a plan to address the financial difficulties faced by the taxpayers of Albany County, and

WHEREAS, This important issue warrants that a Special Committee be impaneled to evaluate and make recommendations to this Honorable Body for consideration and potential implementation of a plan of action, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By This Honorable Body that a Special Committee on Taxation is created to evaluate and make recommendations concerning possible resolutions to the financial difficulties faced by the taxpayers of Albany County, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That said Special Committee shall consist of nine members and the following named persons are hereby appointed to the Special Committee on Taxation:
