

RESOLUTION NO. 270

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH IPRO, INC. REGARDING AUDITING SERVICES PERTAINING TO MEDICAID FRAUD, WASTE AND ABUSE CONTROL ACTIVITIES

By Social Services and Audit and Finance Committees:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 329 for 2011, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with the NYS Department of Health and the NYS Medicaid Inspector General regarding Medicaid fraud, waste and abuse control activities, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has recommended that the County renew the agreement with IPRO, Inc. commencing October 1, 2012 and ending September 30, 2013 in an amount not to exceed \$210,000 to continue auditing services pertaining to Medicaid fraud, waste and abuse control activities, and

WHEREAS, The agreement allows for the review of Medicaid payments made to providers enrolled in the Medicaid program who have submitted claims for eligible services to recipients for which the County has fiscal responsibility, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with IPRO, Inc., 1979 Marcus Avenue, Lake Success, NY commencing October 1, 2012 and ending September 30, 2013 in an amount not to exceed \$210,000 regarding auditing services pertaining to Medicaid fraud, waste and abuse control activities, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
