AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT REGARDING AN AGING NETWORK INFORMATION SERVICES DATA COLLECTION, REPORTING AND CLIENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department for Aging has New York State Office for the Aging and National Aging Program Information System aging program reporting requirements, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Aging, after an RFP process, has requested authorization to enter into a three-year agreement with Peer Place Networks, LLC of Rochester, NY regarding the Peer Place Product commencing April 1, 2013 and ending March 31, 2016 in the amount of \$129,000, and

WHEREAS, The Peer Place Product is a 100% web-based system that will allow for electronic data collection and client referrals in a secure, encrypted fashion, in order to collaborate, share information and provide funder reports with a single master client database and is a proven care-path engine that supports all aging network service types as a best practice model-framework, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a three-year agreement with Peer Place Networks, LLC of Rochester, NY regarding the Peer Place Product commencing April 1, 2013 and ending March 31, 2016 in the amount of \$129,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
