AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 432 FOR 2012: ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR PEARL STREET COUNSELING AND AMENDING THE 2013 MENTAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 432 for 2012, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with Pearl Street Counseling in the amount of \$407,654 for the provision of a medically supervised outpatient clinic for citizens of Albany County suffering from the symptoms or effects of alcoholism for the term January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Mental Health has been notified by the NYS Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services that an additional \$1,121 has been allocated to Pearl Street Counseling, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 432 for 2012 is amended to indicate that the fee corresponding to Pearl Street Counseling is \$408,775 rather than \$407,654, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2013 Mental Health Department Budget is amended to incorporate said funding as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3486 Narcotics Addiction Control by \$1,121

Increase Appropriation Account A4230.4 by \$1,121 by increasing Line Item A4230 4 4415 Pearl Street Counseling by \$1,121

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
