

RESOLUTION NO. 70

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH KETCO, INC. REGARDING THE CR 402 (LOWER CHAPEL HILL ROAD) HIGHWAY REHABILITATION PROJECT IN THE TOWN OF WESTERLO

By Public Works Committee and Ms. Busch:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested authorization to move forward with the County Route 402 (Lower Chapel Hill Road) rehabilitation project in the Town of Westerlo, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the reconstruction of the County Route 402 project includes reconstruction of the existing roadway, replacement of cross-culvert and driveway pipes, installation of under drains, installation of box beam guide rails, pavement striping and new traffic signs, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, through the County Purchasing Agent, issued a request for bids and on February 4, 2013 eleven bids were received pertaining to the project, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works engineering staff reviewed said bids and recommended awarding the contract to KETCO, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with KETCO, Inc., 50 Colvin Avenue, Suite 103, Albany, New York 12206 in an amount not to exceed \$3,057,461 regarding the County Route 402 (Lower Chapel Hill Road) rehabilitation project in the Town of Westerlo, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
