AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT REGARDING THE EXPLOSIVE DETECTION CANINE TEAM PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement with the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding the Explosive Detection Canine Team grant in the amount of \$15,000 for the period April 1, 2013 to August 31, 2014, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has indicated the grant will provide for the training of the canine and handler, the purchase of equipment as needed for the progression of the team and general program sustainment and enhancement, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application to the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding the Explosive Detection Canine Team grant in the amount of \$15,000 for the period April 1, 2013 to August 31, 2014, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
