

RESOLUTION NO. 111

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS CANAL CORPORATION REGARDING REIMBURSEMENT FOR MARINE PATROL SERVICES

By Public Safety Committee and Mr. Clenahan:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement with the NYS Canal Corporation regarding the reimbursement for Marine Patrol Services along the canals and canal-way trail in the amount of \$40,000 with a 25% County match up to a maximum amount of \$10,000 commencing April 1, 2013 and ending March 31, 2014, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that funding will be used to enforce efforts in the waterways leading into the canal system at the Hudson River entry point, providing a unique opportunity to enforce maritime regulations prior to entry into the canal thus making the canal system safer for its users, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement with the NYS Canal Corporation regarding the reimbursement for Marine Patrol Services along the canals and canal-way trail in the amount of \$40,000 with a 25% County match up to a maximum amount of \$10,000 commencing April 1, 2013 and ending March 31, 2014, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
