

RESOLUTION NO. 122

**REQUESTING THE NYS LEGISLATURE TO ENACT LEGISLATION
AMENDING THE TAX LAW AUTHORIZING ALBANY COUNTY TO
CONTINUE THE ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX**

Introduced: 4/8/13

By Mr. Morse:

WHEREAS, An extension of the one percent in the sales and compensating use taxes is due to expire on November 30, 2013 in Albany County which serves to raise additional revenue to offset the costs of mandated programs and assist the towns and cities within Albany County to continue providing vital services without increasing property taxes, and

WHEREAS, The continuation of said one percent in the sales and compensating use tax must be authorized by the State Legislature, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature, pursuant to Article IX of the New York State Constitution and Section 2 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, that the County Legislature hereby requests the enactment of legislation by the Legislature of the State of New York to allow the County of Albany to continue the one percent sales and compensating use tax, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate State and County Officials.
