

RESOLUTION NO. 148

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES REGARDING THE RE-ENTRY TASK FORCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Mental Health has requested authorization to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement with the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the Re-entry Task Force Program in Albany County in the amount of \$195,840 for the period July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014, and

WHEREAS, The Director indicated that the goal of the program is to reduce recidivism by providing essential services that support behavioral change in individuals returning from State prison to the community, and

WHEREAS, The Director indicated that the core requirements will help ensure that those individuals served who present the greatest risk will be prioritized for services and that a needs assessment is conducted for each program participant, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application to the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the Re-entry Task Force Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the Re-entry Task Force Program in Albany County in an amount not to exceed \$195,840 for the period July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
