AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH BPI PIPING, INC. REGARDING MECHANICAL CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR RENOVATIONS OF THE SECOND FLOOR AT THE HAROLD L. JOYCE OFFICE BUILDING

By Audit and Finance Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of General Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement for mechanical construction services for renovations on the 2nd floor of the Harold L. Joyce Office Building, and

WHEREAS, The Department of General Services through the County Purchasing Agent issued a request for proposals and five bids were received regarding mechanical construction services, and

WHEREAS, The Department of General Services and the Purchasing Agent reviewed said bids and recommended awarding the contract to BPI Piping, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with BPI Piping, Inc., 95 Hudson River Rd., Waterford, New York 12188 in an amount not to exceed \$276,904 to provide mechanical construction services for renovations on the 2nd floor of the Harold L. Joyce Office Building located at 112 State Street in the City of Albany, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
