

RESOLUTION NO. 186

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF GENERAL SERVICES REGARDING THE SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY FOR VARIOUS COUNTY FACILITIES

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 428 for 2004, this Honorable Body established the Albany County Energy Advisory Group consisting of the Commissioner of the Department of Management and Budget, the Purchasing Agent and the Executive Director of the Sewer District to act as the County's agent to obtain the lowest prices and the best terms pertaining to the purchase of natural gas and electric energy on behalf of the County, and

WHEREAS, The Energy Advisory Group has met with the New York State Office of General Services (OGS), has thoroughly evaluated the opportunities available from its Energy Service Company and has requested approval to enter into an agreement with OGS for electric supply to four County facilities in an amount not to exceed \$320,000 commencing August 1, 2013 and ending May 31, 2014, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office of General Services regarding the supply of electricity to four County facilities in an amount not to exceed \$320,000 commencing August 1, 2013 and ending May 31, 2014, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
