AUTHORIZING SERVICE AGREEMENTS REGARDING PRESCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN AGES 3- 5

WHEREAS, The County Department for Children, Youth and Families is required to provide an approved preschool special education program for children ages three to five years old who have been evaluated and determined by the Board of Education to have a disabling condition, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter into agreements with service providers who have been approved by the Board of Education to provide mandated Individualized Education Programs through Related Services to meet the physical and educational needs of children of children ages 3 – 5 years old with disabilities, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into agreements with the following preschool special education program providers in regards to mandated Individualized Education Programs through Related Services to meet the physical and educational needs of children ages 3 – 5 years old with disabilities for sums not to exceed the New York State established rates for said services for a term commencing July 1, 2013 and terminating June 30, 2014:
