

RESOLUTION NO. 243

CREATING A LOCAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING WITH THE ONGOING OPERATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE ALBANY COUNTY NURSING HOME

By Messrs. Morse, Commisso and Ward:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Executive and members of the Albany County Legislature have been working together to develop an operating structure that would help to ensure the long term sustainability of the Albany County Nursing Home, and

WHEREAS, After significant research and analysis, it has been determined that a local development corporation formed under the Section 1411 of the New York State Not For Profit Corporation Law (“NFPCL”) can be created to assist with the ongoing operation and administration of the Albany County Nursing Home, and

WHEREAS, A local development corporation formed under the NFPCL is empowered to take the following actions: to disseminate information and furnish advice, technical assistance and liaison with federal, state and local authorities with respect thereto; to acquire by purchase, lease, gift, bequest, devise or otherwise real or personal property or interests therein; to borrow money and to issue negotiable bonds, notes and other obligations therefor; and to sell, lease, mortgage or otherwise dispose of or encumber any of its real or personal property or any interest therein upon such terms as it may determine to be suitable, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature authorizes the formation of a local development corporation in accordance with Section 1411 of the NFPCL regarding the ongoing operation of the Albany County Nursing Home, the seven members of which shall be appointed as follows: three members appointed by the Chairman of the Legislature; three members appointed by the Majority Leader of the Legislature; and one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the Legislature, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That this Honorable Body approves the form and substance of the certificate of incorporation as filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, all in substantially the form thereof presented to the Legislature this meeting, with such changes, variations, omissions and insertions as the Chairman and the County Attorney shall approve, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is hereby directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
