

RESOLUTION NO. 311

AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF A PARCEL OF LAND IN THE TOWN OF KNOX TO THE MOHAWK HUDSON LAND CONSERVANCY

Introduced: 9/9/13

By Conservation and Improvement Committee:

WHEREAS, The County has become the owner of a 4.9 acre parcel of land in the Town of Knox, referred to as Tax Map parcel number 24.00-2-16, and

WHEREAS, The parcel is landlocked and has environmental and topological constraints, and therefore has little value other than as an addition to the Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy's holdings in the Bozenkill Protected Area, and

WHEREAS, The conveyance would be a donation with no compensation required from the conservancy and all maintenance and stewardship costs associated with the parcel will be assumed by the Conservancy, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to execute on behalf of the County any documents necessary to convey the aforementioned parcel to the Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy for the purpose of incorporation into the Conservancy's Bozenkill Protected Area, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said conveyance as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
