

RESOLUTION NO. 343

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS REGARDING LONG TERM CARE POINT OF ENTRY SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Department for Aging has requested an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging regarding available NY Connect grant funds available for the Long Term Care Point of Entry Services Program in the amount of \$62,141 for the period commencing October 1, 2012 and ending September 30, 2013, and

WHEREAS, The Long Term Care Point of Entry Services provide information, screening, referral/linkage assistance and public education to all persons in need of long term care services, regardless of age or income, and

WHEREAS, The Department has also requested authorization to enter into an interdepartmental agreement with the Department of Social Services regarding the provision of Long Term Care Point of Entry Services in the amount of \$62,141 for the period commencing October 1, 2012 and ending September 30, 2013, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$62,141 and an interdepartmental agreement between the Department for Aging and the Department of Social Services in the amount of \$62,141 regarding the provision of Long Term Care Point of Entry Services commencing October 1, 2012 and ending September 30, 2013, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
