

RESOLUTION NO. 456

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT REGARDING THE REPLACEMENT AND UPGRADE OF THE ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEM FOR COUNTY OFFICE BUILDINGS

By Audit and Finance Committee:

WHEREAS, The Department of General Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with SI Technologies, Inc., d/b/a Security Integrations regarding the replacement and upgrade of the Access Control System for County Office Buildings, and

WHEREAS, It was indicated that the access control system is approximately fifteen years old and is inefficient and obsolete, and

WHEREAS, Security Integrations will install a new CCure 9000 contemporary card access system at 112 State Street with all remote locations being connected via existing network connections and all existing card readers will be replaced with new technology card readers that will ensure the security of County buildings, and

WHEREAS, It was indicated that the project will be 100% funded by the State Homeland Security Grant Program, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with SI Technologies, Inc., d/b/a Security Integrations, 14 Petra Lane, Albany NY 12205 regarding the replacement and upgrade of the Access Control System for County office buildings in an amount not to exceed \$370,550.60, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
