

RESOLUTION NO. 463

**REQUESTING THE ALBANY COUNTY COMPTROLLER TO REVIEW
BUDGET ITEMS PERTAINING TO COUNTY EMPLOYEE POSITIONS**

By Messrs. Commisso, Morse, Ward and Ms. Maffia-Tobler:

WHEREAS, Albany County is facing one of the biggest budget deficits in recent history and there must be a determination if County tax payer dollars are being used efficiently, and

WHEREAS, By previous legislation, this Honorable Body imposed restrictions on employee travel in an attempt to arrest spending on matters outside the required core services, and for similar reasons, this Honorable Body also imposed restrictions on the purchase of office equipment, and

WHEREAS, As this Honorable Body prepares to review the 2014 budget additional measures must be taken to control expenditures within the County, but at the same time, information must be obtained prior to making rational policy determinations, and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of this Honorable Body that the Albany County Comptroller assist in the effort to obtain such information by reviewing budget items pertaining to employee positions, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the County Comptroller is requested to review the aforementioned and to report his findings as expeditiously as possible, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
