AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC. REGARDING THE PURCHASE AND MAINTENANCE OF EQUIPMENT TO DEVELOP AN INTEROPERABLE RADIO SYSTEM FOR USE THROUGHOUT ALBANY COUNTY

By Audit and Finance Committee:

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into agreements with Motorola Solutions, Inc. regarding the purchase of equipment to develop an interoperable radio system for use throughout Albany County in the amount of \$18,500,000 and a ten year system maintenance agreement in the amount of \$5,844,556, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that the County wide 800 megahertz communications system project will create an interoperable radio system for forty Fire and EMS Departments, eleven Police Departments within Albany County and also have the ability to be utilized by non-public safety governmental agencies, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that his Office has secured a \$6,000,000 grant for interoperable communications and is in the process of applying for additional grant funding, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff also indicated that the costs associated with the maintenance of this system will be shared by municipalities utilizing the equipment, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into agreements with Motorola Solutions, Inc., 5 Paragon Drive, Montvale, NJ 07645 regarding the purchase of equipment to develop an interoperable radio system for use throughout Albany County in the amount of \$18,500,000 and a ten year system maintenance agreement in the amount of \$5,844,556, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
