

RESOLUTION NO. 543

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH REGARDING STD-RELATED PREVENTION PROJECTS AND AMENDING THE 2013 HEALTH DEPARTMENT BUDGET

By Health Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Health has been notified of available funding through the New York State Department of Health, Bureau of Sexually Transmitted Disease Prevention and Epidemiology regarding a one-time grant to support STD-related prevention projects, and

WHEREAS, The grant funding will be used to address high STD/HIV rates in Albany County particularly in certain high risk populations by testing, treatment, educational outreach, media campaign and training opportunities, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Department of Health in the amount of \$49,000 for the period beginning August 1, 2013 and ending December 31, 2013, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has also requested a budget amendment in order to incorporate the aforementioned funding, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Department of Health regarding STD-related prevention projects in an amount not to exceed \$49,000 for the period beginning August 1, 2013 and ending December 31, 2013, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2013 Department of Health Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A4414 HIV Surveillance by \$49,000

Increase Appropriation Account A4010.4 by \$49,000 by increasing the following line items:

Increase Line Item A4010 4 4020 Office Supplies by \$9,000

Increase Line Item A4010 4 4023 Medical Supplies by \$5,750

Increase Line Item A4010 4 4038 000 Travel, Mileage, and Freight by \$3,250

Increase Line Item A4010 4 4042 000 Printing and Advertising by \$16,000

Increase Line Item A4010 4 4046 000 Fees for Service by \$15,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
