WHEREAS, On November 5, 2013, the voters of New York State approved Proposition One which provides economic opportunities in areas including the Capital District Region, and

WHEREAS, This Honorable Body has a long history of encouraging the development of new and expanding businesses, and the potential economic benefits resulting from the Economic Development Act in Albany County may assist with the creation of well-paying jobs, promote tourism, provide much needed revenue and opportunities to provide lower property taxes, and

WHEREAS, This Honorable Body believes that acting as quickly as possible will enhance the likelihood of success, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature, in order to fully take advantage of this economic opportunity offered by the Upstate New York Gaming Economic Development Act of 2013, that the County Executive is requested to seek any and all possible economic opportunities on behalf of Albany County, and, be it further
