AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS OFFICE FOR THE AGING REGARDING THE COMMUNITY LIVING PROGRAM GRANT AND AMENDING THE 2010 DEPARTMENT FOR AGING BUDGET

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Aging has been notified by the NYS Office for the Aging that funds are available for the Community Living Program Grant, and

WHEREAS, The Community Living Program Grant will provide Albany County with the opportunity to implement a consumer direct program for non-Medicaid eligible individuals age 60 and over in managing their own home care services thereby enabling consumers to maintain quality lives in their own homes, neighborhoods and communities as an alternative to nursing home placement, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$150,000 commencing September 30, 2009 and ending September 29, 2010 regarding Community Living Program Grant, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$150,000 commencing September 30, 2009 and ending September 29, 2010 regarding the Community Living Program Grant, and, be it further

RESOLVED, In order to incorporate the aforementioned funding, the 2010 Department for Aging Budget is amended as follows:

Create and Increase Revenue Account A4781 Community Living Program by \$150,000

Increase Appropriation Account A6772.4 by \$150,000 by increasing the following Line Items:

Increase Line Item A6772 4 4039 000 Conference, Training, Tuition by \$2,442

Increase Line Item A6772 4 4046 000 Fees for Services by \$147,558

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
