AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONAL SERVICES' OFFICE OF NUTRITIONAL SERVICES REGARDING FOOD SERVICE AT THE ALBANY COUNTY CORRECTIONAL FACILITY

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Correctional Service' Office of Nutritional Services (DOCS-NS) to begin the implementation of a new food program at the Correctional Facility, and

WHEREAS, DOCS-NS has developed a cook-chill food program at the Oneida Correctional Facility where large quantities of food are cooked to a just done state then chilled at a rapid rate and stored under tightly controlled conditions, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that since the food would only require reheating, the new process provides the County with an opportunity to save substantial tax dollars, estimated to be \$125,000 for 2010, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with NYS Department of Correctional Service' Office of Nutritional Services regarding the purchase of various food products for the Albany County Correctional Facility in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 for a term commencing June 1, 2010 and ending May 31, 2013, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
