WHEREAS, Albany County has done preliminary studies regarding the building of a new Albany County Nursing Home, and

WHEREAS, The New York State Health Department requires that a Certificate of Need be submitted which details the scope and costs of the aforementioned new Albany County Nursing Home in order for grant funding to be given to such projects, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a Certificate of Need application to the New York State Department of Health regarding the building of a new Albany County Nursing Home, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That upon notification of a grant award, a representative of the Albany County Nursing Home will report said results to the Legislative Special Nursing Home Facilities Committee, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said Certificate of Need application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
