

RESOLUTION NO. 16

AUTHORIZING SALARY ADJUSTMENTS REGARDING NINE CIVILIAN POSITIONS IN THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT REPRESENTED BY THE CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION

By Law and Public Safety Committees:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested a budget amendment to reflect the adjustment of salaries for nine non-security personnel positions under terms of a stipulation of settlement reached between the Sheriff's Department and the Civil Service Employees Association, Local 1000, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that the stipulation, which ends a grievance before the New York State Public Employment Relations Board, involves employees holding the job titles of Data Entry Operator, Account Clerk I and II, Clerk I and Clerk Typist who work at Sheriff's Offices at the Court House and STOP DWI offices in Cohoes, and

WHEREAS, Under terms of the settlement, the nine employees become union members, receive salaries commensurate with the CSEA pay scale for their individual years of service retroactive to June 30, 2008, and move from a 35-hour to 40-hour work week effective November 28, 2008, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2009 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended to implement said stipulation of settlement with salary adjustments as indicated in a spreadsheet filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
