DETERMINATION THAT THE TAN HOLLOW ROAD OVER THE HANNACROIS CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN THE TOWN OF WESTERLO WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT

By Audit and Finance Committee:

WHEREAS, Albany County proposes to build a new pre-cast concrete bridge on Tan Hollow Road over the Hannacrois Creek in the Town of Westerlo to replace the existing I-beam structure installed about 1952 and currently rated at the minimum acceptable level by the New York State Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS, The proposed engineering/design and construction work is subject to the requirements of State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has assumed the designation of Lead Agency for the purpose of compliance with SEQR, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning, acting on behalf of the Albany County Legislature has reviewed the proposed action and has complied with all applicable administrative and procedural requirements on behalf of the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature has considered the findings of the Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning and has determined that the proposed project is a Type II action and will not have a significant effect on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That no other determinations or procedures are required with respect to this proposed project in accordance with the requirements set forth in the applicable administrative and procedural requirements of SEQR, although the project is subject to all pertinent State and Federal permit requirements that may apply to replacement of bridges, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
