

RESOLUTION NO. 128

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 411 FOR 2008 REGARDING PREVENTIVE SERVICES FOR CHILDREN

Introduced: 4/13/09

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 411 for 2008 the Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families requested authorization to extend the agreements with preventive service providers to March 31, 2009 rather than December 31, 2008 allowing sufficient time to prepare new proposals, and

WHEREAS, It has been determined that the agreements with preventive service providers should be extended again through June 30, 2009 to allow time to review the newly submitted proposals and determine the potential impact on providers, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 411 for 2008 is amended to indicate that the term of the agreements with the following preventive service providers is extended to June 30, 2009 rather than March 31, 2009 at the amounts indicated:
