

RESOLUTION NO. 135

AMENDING THE 2009 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET: ADDITIONAL FUNDING REGARDING THE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

By Public Safety Committee and Mr. Scavo:

WHEREAS, The NYS Governor's Traffic Safety Committee has informed the Albany County Sheriff that an additional \$11,500 is available for the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program for the period October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2009, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that his Department anticipated an amount of \$20,000 for the program and the additional \$11,500 will assist his Department to establish an education effort targeted at the enforcement community as well as the general public regarding aggressive driving, which includes failure to yield right of way, following too closely, unsafe passing or lane change, disregarding traffic control devices and running red lights and stop signs, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2009 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended to incorporate said additional funding as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A1589 Sheriff DWI Revenues by \$11,500

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.1 by \$7,500 by increasing Line Item A3110 1 9900 000 Overtime by \$7,500

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.2 by \$4,000 by increasing Line Item A3110 2 2800 000 Specialty Equipment by \$4,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
