WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the State University at Albany School of Social Welfare regarding the development of the Albany County-New York Connects Intern Program, and

WHEREAS, The University at Albany School of Social Welfare Center for Excellence in Aging Services Internship Program will provide interns to support administrative, reporting, programmatic, and conducting data analysis and research for Albany County-New York Connects, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that a Memorandum of Understanding will include a non-disclosure agreement that allows access to client and provider information for conducting data entry and analysis related to Albany County-New York Connects, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the University at Albany School of Social Welfare regarding the Albany County-New York Connects Intern Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
