

RESOLUTION NO. 176

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS REGARDING INFRASTRUCTURE AND ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS TO THE RAILROAD AVENUE CORRIDOR

By Audit and Finance Committee:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 474 for 2008, this Honorable Body authorized the submission of a joint grant application with the Towns of Colonie and Guilderland to the Capital District Transportation Committee Linkage Planning Program to fund a study on the Railroad Avenue Corridor, and

WHEREAS, The County Executive's Office has been informed that the Capital District Transportation Committee Linkage Planning Program has awarded the grant, and

WHEREAS, The grant funding is to be used to hire a consultant to identify access and infrastructure improvements to the Railroad Avenue corridor which is part of the Albany County Empire Zone, and

WHEREAS, The grant, in the amount of \$50,000, has a 25% cash match to which the Town of Colonie has committed \$5,000, the Town of Guilderland has committed \$2,500 and Albany County as the lead agency has committed \$5,000, with CDTC providing \$37,500 in federal funds, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into agreements with the Capital District Transportation Committee and the Towns of Colonie and Guilderland in the amount of \$50,000 as described above to fund a study on the Railroad Avenue Corridor, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
