

RESOLUTION NO. 363

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CALLANAN INDUSTRIES, INC. REGARDING THE RESURFACING OF CR52 (ELM AVENUE) FROM THE DELMAR BYPASS TO FEURA BUSH ROAD IN THE TOWN OF BETHLEHEM AS AN ECONOMIC RECOVERY PROGRAM PROJECT

By Public Works Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested authorization to move forward with the resurfacing of CR52 (Elm Avenue) to SR32 in the Town of Bethlehem in order to keep pace with ever-increasing traffic volume and remedy roadway surface imperfections, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the resurfacing of County Route 52 (Elm Avenue) to SR32 in the Town of Bethlehem includes the production milling, asphalt resurfacing, replacement of existing inductance loop wire, shoulder back-up and pavement striping, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, through the County Purchasing Agent, issued a request for bids and on September 10, 2009, four bids were received pertaining to the project, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works reviewed said bids and recommended awarding the contract to Callanan Industries, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Callanan Industries, Inc., 1245 Kings Road, Schenectady, New York in an amount not to exceed \$211,117.70 regarding the resurfacing of CR52 (Elm Avenue) to SR32 in the Town of Bethlehem, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
